Your Time On The Land

Welcome to our Dreamcatcher family! We look forward to meeting you for your Time on the Land with us!

Due to Covid 19 in 2020: SAFETY IS OUR BIGGEST CONCERN

Only Book Time If:

- a. You have not been out of the country or in contact with anyone who has or if you have, you have quarantined for 14 days.
 - b. You do not have cold or flu like symptoms and have not been in contact with anyone who has.
 - c. You are practicing the current social distancing rules.
- Time on the Land visits are offered to 2 families within each hour so practicing physical distancing from others on the land is important. Choosing to go in another direction from any other family is recommended and encouraged.
 - Please do not bring your pets.
 - Please do not go inside any of the animal enclosures for safety purposes. Due to social distancing, we cannot be with you.
 - Please do not enter any enclosed buildings on the property.
 - There is an outhouse on the property if needed. There is no access to hot, running water but hand sanitizer is provided.

Please sign and witness the waivers we have provided. These must be returned prior to your visit.

What To Bring:

- Dress in layers as it is colder here than in the city (typically at least 2 degrees colder)
- Rubber boots if you choose to hike the back 40.
- Bread if you wish to feed the chickens (they love bread!)

What You Can Do/Expect:

- Walk the trails on the back 40. Some may be wet in places if it has been raining.
- Check out the ranch. Spend time outside. It may be muddy down there.
- Pet and feed the horses and donkeys over the fence. We have apples or treats you may be able to give them (limited amount for them and only if you are comfortable).
- Sit on the benches on the property and observe the animals in nature.
- Feed the chickens some bread through the fences in their outdoor coops.
- Picnic with your family at the picnic table in the general area or in the back 40 if you prefer. Please clean up all garbage before you leave.
- Feel free to take pictures.
- If you have positive feedback about your visit, please post it on our Facebook page.

There will be up to two families here at a time. Please social distance from people you don't know and keep children from engaging closely with other children they don't know. Sometimes Dreamcatcher volunteers or staff may be on the land at the same time, but they will social distance from you and are working if they are here.

You may stay longer than an hour and again, we ask that you avoid other families if you do.

Visits are \$20/family. All proceeds from your visit go toward the daily care of the animals and the maintenance of the visit program.

Visits may need to be rescheduled because of inclement weather. If reschedule dates do not work with your schedule, a refund will be offered. This is the only circumstance refunds are considered. Tickets are transferrable.
